

Canal Heritage Days at Waterloo

July 13 and 27, August 10, September 14 and 28 and October 12 and 26



For the 7th year the Canal Society is partnering with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the State Park Service to co-sponsor Canal Heritage Days at Waterloo. These days will be held rain or shine. On these days the grounds of the village will be open to the public, guided tours will be offered of the village and the canal, our New Jersey Canal Museum will be open, and on most of the dates our boat ride on the canal will be offered. In addition, Smith's Store, the Rutan Cabin, the Blacksmith Shop and the Gristmill will be open for interpretation. The Society continues to work with the State to be able to make other buildings in the village available to the public in the future. This year's Waterloo Canal Heritage Days will be held on July 13 and 27, August 10, September 14 and 28 and October 12 and 26. On all of these Saturdays Waterloo will be open to the public from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. free of charge. Our goal is to offer the public an opportunity to experience the unique canal heritage of Waterloo, despite the fact that the site is closed during much of the year.
